Marking touchers with chalk	Players/markers	none	3 - 4	As we aren't allowed to touch others woods due to risk of cross contamination spary chalk is highly recomended to mark touchers during the game, The use of solid chalk is still permitted only to mark around a live wood in the ditch, one person on each side of the mat should be designated to do this and if possible should use hand sanitiser before and after marking the woods to lower the chance of cross contamination.	1
